The side loader is designed for use in a variety of applications from pipe to flat sheet metal stock to lumber and more. A side loader offers the advantage of reduced aisle width, allowing for the storage of much more material in the same amount of storage space. A traditional front loading forklift requires aisle widths that not only accommodate the length of the load, but also additional width to allow the forklift to turn into the storage area, deposit or pick up the load and then manoeuvre out again. With a side loader, not only is the aisle width much lower, which increases the storage density, but the entire operation is safer.
